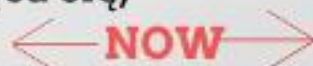


Present Simple - zwyczaj, cecha, czynność powtarzająca się,

He / she / it eats fruit every day.

czasem -y -> -ies hurry ^{spółgłoska} -> hurries ale play ^{samogłoska} -> plays

dress -> dresses

does he / she / it }

Do you sometimes help your sister? Yes, I do. No, I don't.

Does you cat often eat mice?

Yes, it does. No, it doesn't.

What do your children never eat? Fish.



I / we / you / they do not (don't) }
he / she / it does not (doesn't) }
